Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.		
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have• Social Security number• Transaction or loss history• Account balances• Credit history• Payment history• Wire transfer instructions		
How?	All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons Rancho Federal CU and UFCWCU chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Rancho Federal CU and UFCWCU protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.	
How does Rancho Federal CU and UFCWCU collect my personal information?	<ul> <li>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</li> <li>Pay your bills</li> <li>Use your credit or debit card</li> <li>Give us your income information</li> <li>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, consumer credit reporting agencies, or other companies.</li> </ul>

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.	
Definitions		
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. • <i>Rancho Federal CU and UFCWCU has no affiliates.</i>	
Nonaffiliates	<ul> <li>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.</li> <li><i>Rancho Federal CU and UFCWCU does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i></li> </ul>	
Joint Marketing	<ul> <li>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</li> <li>Our joint marketing partners include credit card companies, insurance companies and mortgage companies.</li> </ul>

For Alaska, Illinois, Maryland and North Dakota Members. We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization.

**For California Members.** We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization. We will also limit our sharing of personal information about you with our affiliates to comply with all California privacy laws that apply to us.

For Massachusetts, Mississippi and New Jersey Members. We will not share personal information from deposit or share relationships with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization.
