

Step #1: Enroll in our New System

- Olick the "ONLINE BANKING" button from our homepage.
- Olick "Enroll now" to begin.
- Provide the prompted information so that we may verify your identity.

NOTE: The information you enter must match the information we have on file for you. If the information does not match, you will not be able to complete the automated enrollment process until we have updated your information in our system. Your member number is what was given to you when you opened your account with Rancho FCU.

Proceed through the 2-Step Verification process to receive a code to verify your identity. Once you complete this process, you will be prompted to establish a new username and password.

Your new username must:

• Be 8-20 characters with no special characters

Your new password must:

- Be 8-20 characters long
- · Contain upper & lowercase letters
- · Contain at least one number
- Contain a special character
- You must mark the box acknowledging that you agree to the terms set forth in the Online Banking Disclosure.

This will complete your enrollment.

Once you have completed this step, you have successfully completed your enrollment! If you wish to change your login in the future, you can do so by going to your **Profile & Settings**.
